Analyst's Verdict: Several with chances in an ultra-competitive opener. **Setting Sail's** lightly-raced profile provides hope for further progress and he gets a narrow vote ahead of the reliable Beringer and William Knight's Soto Sizzler. Ventura Knight, whose yard has won this 4 times since 2009, and Johnny Drama are also on the shortlist.

Analyst's Verdict: Pinatubo's decisive Chesham win is backed up by the clock and providing he handles the track (didn't look at home at Epsom but classy enough to overcome it in the Woodcote) he will take all the beating. Visinari remains a fine prospect despite his July Stakes reversal, and while it's hard to envisage Lope Y Fernandez reversing Ascot form with Pintatubo, he's still of interest at this level.

Analyst's Verdict: Cross Counter did well to finish as close as he did when fourth to Stradivarius at Royal Ascot, having been held up in a steadily-run race. A strong end-to-end gallop is pretty much assured this time and, back at the course where he broke the 1½m track record last year, he is taken to get the better of the champion stayer. Dee Ex Bee, who was runner-up in the Gold Cup, should again be in the mix.



Analyst's Verdict: It could pay to keep the faith with Layaleena. It's easy to excuse a poor run at Royal Ascot and she'd previously impressed when running away with a useful Nottingham handicap (the third is now rated in the 110s having won a listed race at Ascot on Friday). She can get back on track, with Al Messila and Salayel feared most.
