Ascot Stakes winner The Grand Visir and Early Summer are other key players.

**Analyst's Verdict:** **Liberty Beach** was clearly better than the result in the Queen Mary and duly showed herself a potentially smart sprinter with an emphatic success in a listed race at Sandown. She sets a clear standard and can see off the challenge of the unbeaten Maven, who has a 3 lb penalty after his narrow Group 3 win at Chantilly. The fast-improving Alligator Alley makes each-way appeal at bigger odds.

Fellow 3-y-o Circus Maximus had the selection and Phoenix of Spain in behind when winning the St James's Palace at Royal Ascot last time and is an obvious threat.



**Analyst's Verdict:** Unexposed 3-y-os **Lyndon B** and **Light And Dark** are expected to come to the fore. The latter isn't passed over lightly on the back of his emphatic handicap debut success, but Lyndon B was value for more than the winning margin at Leicester recently and an 8 lb rise may well underestimate him. Fellow last-time-out winner **Blackheath** is best of the rest, while **Charles Molson** is also accorded respect.
